- 1. Job title: Assistant Professor, Division of Marine Life Science, Laboratory of Marine Chemical Resource Development
- **2. Job description**: Full-time, untenured, 5-year contract with the possibility of one 5-year extension (maximum of 10 years in total). Renewal of contract will be determined based on a review of teaching and research achievements after 5 years.
- **3. Field**: Natural product chemistry and biochemistry to develop marine bioresources. Specifically, education and research on the chemical utilization of bioresources derived from unutilized and underutilized aquatic species and fishery wastes.
- 4. Qualifications: Applicants must have a doctoral degree, demonstrated ability in research, and high motivation.
- **5. Teaching responsibilities**: Teaching undergraduate students in Department of Marine Bioresources Chemistry and graduate students in Laboratory of Marine Chemical Resource Development (lectures, laboratory work, training, seminars, etc.)
- 6. Start date: Between April 1 and October 1, 2018 (negotiable)
