

# Hokkaido Study Abroad Program 2022

## 1 目的

大学の留学生を高校に派遣し、授業のサポート

や母国の紹介、生徒との交流を通して、高校生の

英語力の向上などに貢献するとともに、日本の

高校における教育活動に参加し、理解を深める。

## 2 派遣する高校

本人や高校の希望を参考に、北海道教育

委員会と大学が派遣先を決定する。

## 3 実施期間

9月5日から9月30日までの3日間以内とする。

## 4 プログラムの内容

派遣される高校において、例えば、次のような取組

を企画して実施する。

- (1) 英語を中心とする授業へのサポート(質問対応、ティームティーチングなど)
- (2) 授業への参加(和食の調理や柔道・剣道など、日本文化への理解を深める授業)
- (3) 母国や研究内容の紹介
- (4) 部活動への参加
- (5) 高校生による英語での地域案内
- (6) その他、国際理解を深めることにつながる取組



## 5 募集人数

25名を上限に、予算の範囲内で決定する。

応募者が多い場合は、北海道教育委員会と大学に

おいて抽選を行う。

## 6 参加費用

留学生には、予算の範囲内で派遣に係る旅費(

交通費、宿泊など)と謝礼を支給する。

## 7 事前研修会

北海道教育委員会は、派遣される留学生を

対象に、オンラインで事前研修会を行う。

## 8 その他

本事業は、新型コロナウイルス感染症の感染防

止対策を講じた上で実施し、当該感染症の状況に

よっては、事業の実施を中止することがある。

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## 1 Purpose

In this program, foreign students who study at the university in Hokkaido will be dispatched to Japanese high schools. Through the experience of having international exchanges with Japanese high school students by supporting high school classes, introducing their own country to high school students or taking part in other educational activities, they can contribute to the improvement of high school students' English ability and gain deeper understandings about educational activities in Japanese high schools.

## 2 Dispatch high school

Referring to the students' requests and high schools' requests, the Hokkaido Board of Education and the university will decide where they will be dispatched to.

## 3 Program period

Within three days from September 5 to 30.

## 4 Program contents

Exchange students will be expected to work on activities such as the following examples:

- i) Supporting high school students' learning in English class or other classes by answering their questions, working as a teacher for team-teaching and so on.
- ii) Participating in high school lessons (especially the ones in which they can deepen their understandings about Japanese cultures, such as Japanese food cooking, Judo or Kendo).
- iii) Introducing their home country or the content of research at university.
- iv) Participating in club activities or other activities in which they can interact with high school students.
- v) Visiting some places around the area with them being guided by the Japanese high school students.
- vi) Participating in other activities which encourage their international understandings.



## 5 Number of participants

The number of participants (up to 25) will be settled by the Hokkaido Board of Education within the range of the budget. In the case of there being too many applicants, the Hokkaido Board of Education and the university will hold an event to select the participants through a draw system.

## 6 Participation fee

The amount equivalent to the following costs will be reimbursed within the range of the budget: Commuting expenses (between home and high school), Lodging charges (if necessary) and other rewards.

## 7 Orientation meeting

The Hokkaido Board of Education will have an orientation meeting via online prior to the start of the program.

## 8 Others

Proper measures to prevent novel coronavirus infection will be taken during the program. Depending on the spread of COVID-19, the program might be cancelled.
